

A Special Meeting of the Marilla Town Board was held Tuesday November 9, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. at the Marilla Town Hall, 1740 Two Rod Road, Marilla, New York 14102. Officials present were:

Supervisor Gertz called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m. and the tentative budget was reviewed.

Motion: Councilman Darrow moved, seconded by Councilman Handley to approve the following resolution:

Whereas, the former five-unit apartment building located at 1717 Two Rod Road is no longer inhabitable as a result of a devastating fire; and,

Whereas, the structure has now become an unattractive nuisance for the community and cannot be rehabilitated; and,

Whereas, the structure impedes the community's appearance, and is a health and safety threat to the neighborhood according to the Town's Code Enforcement Officer;

Now therefore be it;

Resolved that the Marilla Town Board hereby officially declare this structure and the facility's immediate surrounding land to be an area of spot blight; and

Be it further;

Resolved that all necessary steps be taken to alleviate said area of spot blight, including submission of a grant application to the Erie County Dept. of Environment & Planning for acquisition and subsequent demolition in order for the Town to restore this land to a vacant, grassy parcel.

The question of the adoption of the foregoing resolution was put to a vote by roll call, which resulted as follows:
